[There used to be lists of possible restrictions signers could choose, but The Land Trust's suggested restrictions are very simple: "No new permanent structures in the area covered by a conservation easement." Signers are allowed to remove trees that are diseased or dead or which constitute threats. It is important to understand that a conservation easement does not take away ownership of the land but merely restricts development rights on the portion covered by the easement.]
